The English School of Mui Ne (ES-MN), Vietnam



A non-profit organization committed to supporting the young, ambitious and less fortunate children of Mui Ne village. The school has 80 students aged between 11-17 years. ES-

MN actively promotes higher education amongst their students, but English and computer skills also hugely increase chances

Luang Prabang Orphanages, Laos



Andrew & La Brown run a project supporting three orphanages in the Luang Prabang area; Deak Kum Pa, Numbuk and Suan Luang. The orphanages are government run and home to children aged 6 to 17. The orphanages also operate as schools providing basic education, thus a possibility of a brighter life in a country where more than a quarter of the population live below the poverty line.

Their organization Support Lao Children also provides for children's health schemes and food programs in selected villages as well as further education (through scholarships) for the children who are old enough to leave the orphanages. Through their different programs, aid reaches approximately 4000 children.



In July 2019 a new nursery was opened by the couple to provide for orphanges up to six years of

age. The nursery is built on the same grounds as the Luang Prabang orphanage which is where the children will move to once they turn six. During 2020 the nursery increased the capacity to host 22 children. There are plans to expand facilities for up to 45 babies & children as long as funding is secured.

The Bread of Life Education Centre, Lebanon



Founded in 2013, the Bread of Life Education Centre is a small Christian charity in the northern part of Lebanon, not far from the Syrian border. With small means they provide schooling for 50 students – all Syrian refugees - aged 5 to 12. Their main focus is

Arabic, English and Maths. They also provide

support to the refugee families. The founders have lived and worked in the region for the past 14 years and speak the local language.



Fundraising activities 2020

Private donations

2020 was a challenging year. Together for charity normally fund raises through a variety of private events & parties which were not possible due to the restrictions that came with the pandemic.

Still a number of private donations were made spontaneously and after appeals via e-mail and through friend networks.

Donation Details 2020

Together for charity managed to support the projects in Vietnam, Laos and Lebanon on a quarterly basis in 2020 with some adjustments for the different projects due to the difficulties in fund raising during the year.

For the English School of Mui Ne in Vietnam, together for charity supported general operational costs such as teacher salaries, housing rental and school materials with 25 000 SEK from quarter 1 through quarter 3 supporting 80 students. The donations were halted for quarter 4 due to lack of funds.

Together for charity continued the support for the Bread of Life Education Centre in Lebanon for the sixth year running. The donation was in keeping with the charity's principles focused on operational support, such as salaries, rental and school supplies. A total of 100 000 SEK was paid in quarterly installments.

In Laos we supported two orphanages, the Luang Prabang orphanage and the Suan Luang orphanage and the funds were dedicated to complementing government food programs with different sources of proteins. Support Lao Children received USD 6 000 (approximately 48 000 SEK) quarter one, two and four during 2020 covering approximately 1000 children. During quarter three there are less children at the orphanages as some go back to visit their villages in the school break thus it was decided to halt donations for that quarter and instead add an extra month of support (approximately 16 000 SEK) to the quarter four donation.

A difficult decision for 2021

Looking back at 2020, a year that has been nothing like anyone could have imagined, together for charity have had to make some tough decisions. Based on the new reality of a steady decline in funds we are unable to maintain the same level of support as in the past. It is with a heavy heart that together for charity has decided to focus on only one project moving forward. Luang Prabang Orphanges have consistently received the largest support and was our first project back in 2011. Through their relentless work we are able to reach a large number of children, hence we will move into 2021 focusing our efforts on Laos.

Together for charity communicated with all three projects early on to make them aware of the situation with declining funds throughout 2020 as it has always been our aim to give ample warning should a situation like this appear. We hope that we will be able to relaunch our support for both the English School of Mui Ne in Vietnam and the Bread of Life Education Centre in Lebanon in the future.
